If more than two Maltese organisations are involved in a single partnership, all Maltese partners will be considered ineligible. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Partnerships addressing the sharing and improvement of teaching and learning methods, best practices and innovative methods of teaching in various areas of education/learning. 2. Partnerships addressing the issue of adult education/learning and improving the flexibility of education/learning provision, particularly in relation to disadvantaged groups. 3. Partnerships addressing the issue adult training methodology through introducing "good practices" in the field of adult training. 4. Partnerships addressing the issue of recognition and validation of knowledge and skills obtained as a result of informal and non-formal learning. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All national priorities carry the same weight; • Projects that do not address any national priorities shall receive '0' points; • Projects addressing one national priority shall receive '10' points; • Projects addressing two or more national priorities shall receive '15' points.
